

## **Summer Camp Safety and Behavior Contract**

Upon signing this document, both the parent and camper agree to the guidelines set forth and will abide by the disciplinary actions issued if this contract is not followed.

- 1. I will be respectful of my fellow campers, and all program staff. This means that I will speak to others in a respectful manner and tone of voice.
- 2. I will refrain from using electronic devices during the duration of the camp for anything other than emergency purposes. Phones will be stored in a cubby to prevent distractions.
- 3. I will follow the directions of my counselor and DVHS Camp staff. I will work my hardest to cooperate with my teammates and other classmates.
- 4. I will participate in hands-on building and programming activities. I will refrain from drifting off-task and will focus on the task at hand.
- 5. I will contribute to the positive learning atmosphere, and will not engage in any horseplay.
- 6. I understand that disrespectful behavior includes, but is not limited to: hitting, punching, kicking, biting, spitting, swearing, lying, throwing, and refusing to listen to the DVHS staff.
- 7. I will not threaten or cause physical harm towards others, including possessing sharp or other dangerous instruments. I will respect the personal space of others and keep my body to myself.
- 8. I will be respectful of the DVHS buildings and any other location I may visit while attending camp. I will not litter, vandalize, steal, or destroy items that do not belong to me.
- 9. I will be respectful of all equipment I am using. I will not throw or intentionally damage parts given to my team or to any other team for any reason.
- 10. I will make sure to follow current COVID safety guidelines and regulations.
- 11. If I am sick for any reason I will make sure to not come to Summer Camp to protect my peers.
- 12. Please note that refunds will not be issued for any classes that are missed, scheduled, or unscheduled. Please plan your schedule accordingly so your child can attend classes on time and make the best of their resources.
- 13. Parents will pick up students after camp in a timely manner, respecting the schedule of DVHS staff and camp counselors.
- 14. I agree to follow all Summer Camp rules above, including those that are not listed on this behavior agreement or rules set forth by my camp director and counselors during the camp day.
